Interview regarding 11/13/2007 “Diana Triangle” UFO Sighting

1) Where were you and what were you doing at the time?

Return trip home to Stockton from San Diego along Highway 5 in California.
Driving near Kettleman City, CA.

2) What made you first notice the object?

Noted unusual lights in the sky

3. What did you think the object was when you first noticed it?

Lights were very unusual, thought it was a UFO.

4. Describe your reactions and actions, during and after sighting the object?

Excited. Got out the binoculars. Stopped auto, got video camera from back of auto.

5. Describe the object and it's actions.

“V” or triangle shaped object with Red lights, which eventually turned white, on it. Object moved slowly, tilted at times, expelled “**comet**” at one time. Object traveled slowly, 20-40mph and made *slow circle patterns* along the eastern boarder of the Highway (never crossed Highway). At times the object hovered directly above us. Later, a very small object with a single light was observed in the area. Possibly the comet object had returned?

6. How did you lose sight of the object? Followed the object northbound in car for some distance. Stopped to buy gas at Chevron station near Panoche Rd. Object disappeared into the East during refuel.

ENVIRONMENTAL SITUATION

Object was viewed from:

First from Auto, then from side of road, then followed in auto again.

Viewed through: Window, Binoculars, Movie Camera

The area was: RURAL (witness returned to area a few days later and noted many TALL radio towers in area, felt it unlikely any traditional aircraft would be flying low in this area for that reason)

Area Terrain: Flat dirt by side of Highway off ramp

Sky Conditions: Clear, dark (crescent moon?)

Precipitation: None

UFO Direction: East of Highway, came up to edge of Highway, never crossed over.

UFO Distance: Between 500-1000 feet when directly overhead

Also in area: Helicopter noted after sighting, flying low.

Object Description

Observed: #1 Object. Appeared Triangle and/or “V” shaped.

Color of object: Black

Observed: Lights, at first Red, but later changed to White. Low intensity. Flashed in various sequences, sometimes NO LIGHTS (black out), sometimes only ONE lights, sometimes several lights (see video). Lights sometimes formed a straight line, sometimes formed a “V” shape.

Sound: NO Sounds heard (note, freeway traffic was very loud with passing vehicles).

Smell: NONE

Speed: Varied, estimated 20-40mph. Hovered at times.

Did the object or light:

Changed Direction YES

Changed Shape (as the object rotated in 3 dimensions) YES

Hovered: Directly overhead, as if “watching us” YES

Descended YES

Ascended YES

Blinked YES, Note: Lights resembled “running lights”, **NOT brilliant** like spotlights.

Have an outline YES

Any other witnesses? Yes, 1 other.

Did any other agency contact you? FAA

ANOMALOUS LIGHTS OR OBJECTS

Number observed: 2 (large object was seen to eject a “comet” like small object.)

Elevation observed: 45 – 90 degrees above horizon

Lowest Altitude: 500-1000 feet

Distance from witness: 500-1000 feet (directly overhead)

Flight: Circular path as object traveled along side highway

Direction first observed: East of Highway

Direction last observed: East of Highway

Shape: Triangle

Surface: Dark

Structural features: Circular Windows, “Portholes”, dark in color located on bottom of craft. The surface had texture.

Apparent size: Like 2 football fields in length

Actual Size: Witeness2 estimate, 600 feet

Prominent Colors: Black

Exterior Light Characteristics: Initially Red, later changed to White. Flashed in some type of sequence

Emission: Object emitted a “comet” like small object at great speed. Object left a trail in the sky.

Sound: None, silent (Note: freeway noise was very loud, may have masked any low volume sounds)

PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS

Curious: during event

Elated: during

Fearful: during

Dreams: after event (abduction dream by Witness2)

Time Lapse: during

Other: Being watched

Physiological Effects

Shook Nervously: During the event

Other: Witness 1; noted hip pain after the event (possibly from long drive)

Lost time: Yes. Checked the camera and only recorded 15 minutes of event. Seemed more like 2 hours to witnesses. Witness wondered if it was possibly affect of adrenaline?

Relationship of UFO or Entity to Affected Person

Indirect: UFO hovered over witness during effects

Psychic interests and abilities:

Interested in psychic phenomena? Yes (Witness 1)

Have psychic abilities? Good intuition

Have abilities been tested? No

VIDEO CAMERA INFO

Make/model: Sony digital HandyCam. (Owned by witness 1)

Model: DCR-PC5

Lens: Carl Zeis Vario-Sonnar with Zero Lux

Focus: Infinity Focus setting was used.

Mode: switched between NORMAL and NIGHTSHOT (did NOT user SuperNighshot setting, too blurry).

Digital Tape used: Sony MiniDV DVM60 (we were shown a digital copy)

Digital Still Camera

(Owned by Witness 2) was also used, but photos came out black. Too dark for still photos.

POST SIGHTING CONTACTS

Witnesses stopped at a gas station near Firebaugh CA.

Ask the station attendant for the local police department number.

Called Firebaugh PD. Dispatcher answered "Sheriff's Department".

Witness reported a UFO. Dispatcher said to expect a call back on witness cell phone and hung up. Apparently a P.D. report was **not** filed. No case number was given.

Within 2 minutes witness got a call back from a man identifying himself as an F.A.A official. "So what's happening?" Witness described the encounter. F.A.A. official gave witness National UFO Reporting Center (NUFORC) "Hot Line" phone number to report the incident. Apparently a F.A.A. report was **not** filed. No case number was given.

Upon arrival home, witness called NUFORC Hot Line. During recounting of incident, the person taking the report discounted the encounter saying "If it was that large, we would have many other calls". Witness felt person taking report was giving her a hard time.

Later that same evening, after showing the video to her father, the father called back and said the girls were serious and had video proof. The NUFORC “Hot line” person was unimpressed. Not sure if a report exists. No case number was given.

RESEARCHER IMPRESSIONS: The ladies were very excited about the encounter. They seemed genuine when recounting the story. With their willingness to be identified, and their attempts to report the incident to multiple authorities, we can probably safely discount a hoax.

What remains is to identify the object they DID see. The lack of traditional aerodynamics (i.e. ability to hover silently etc.) displayed by the object would seem to eliminate normal aircraft. Either it is a “lighter than air” object, an unknown military craft in early test phase (proximity to Naval Air Station may support this). Or a craft of ET origins.

Check with NUFORC, confirm report.

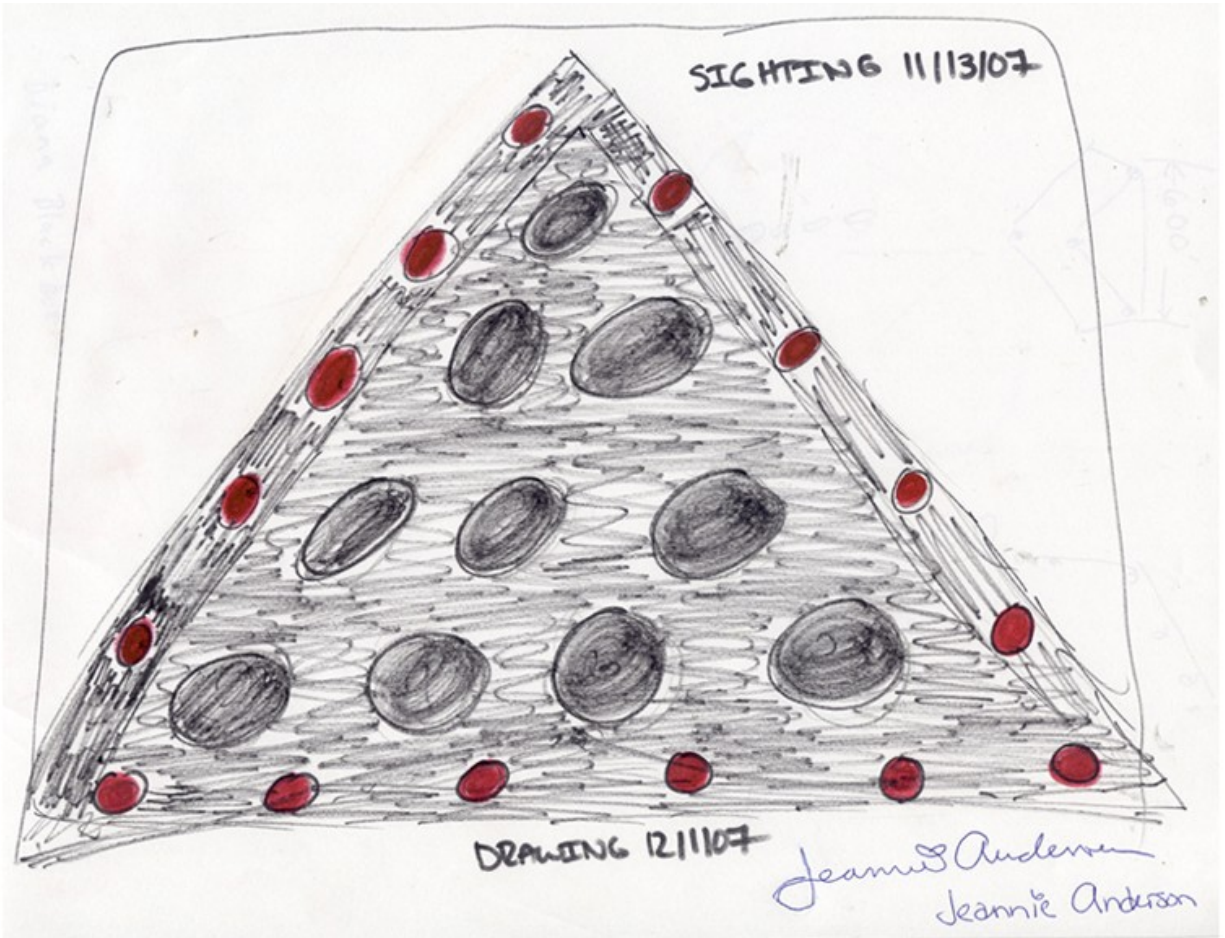

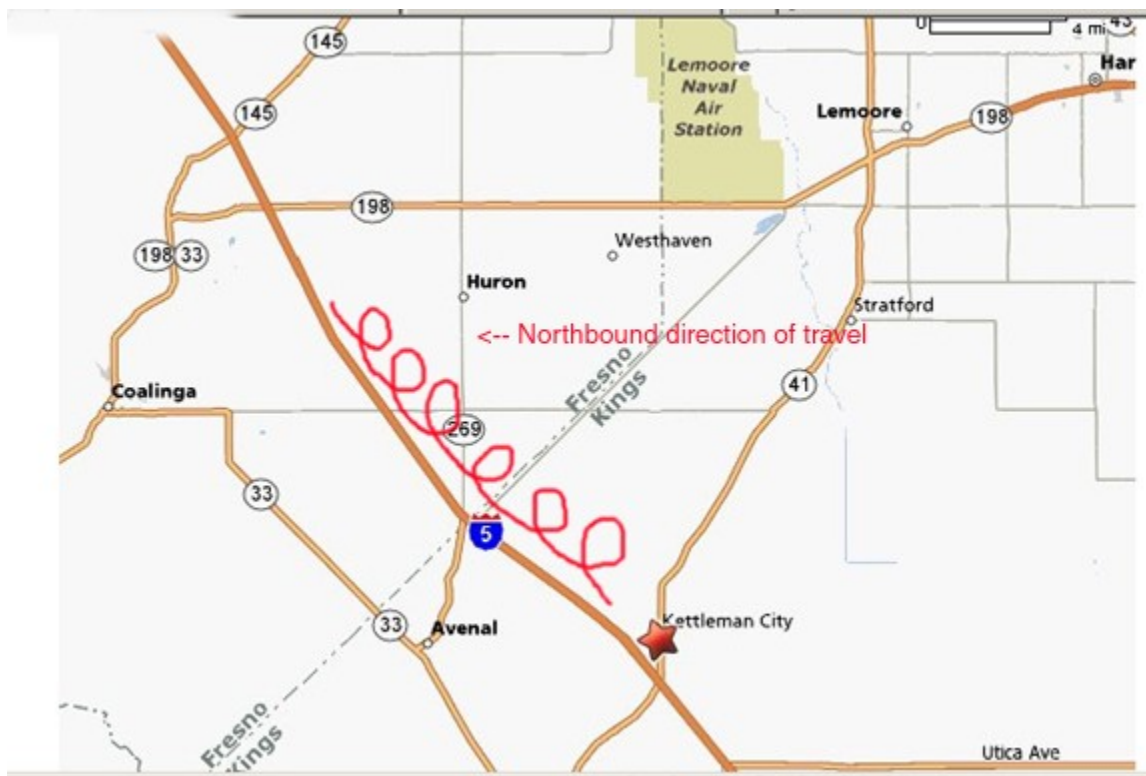

REGIONAL MAPS



Witness described the object as making flying loop off the east side of Highway 5, but never crossing the highway.

It progressed in a northerly fashion.

Variable speeds, estimated from 20-40mph. Occasionally stopped and hovered near the highway's edge.

REGIONAL MAPS (cont.)



The witnesses followed the object up Highway 5 until they reached Panoche Rd.
Pulled into Chevron Gas Station to purchase gas. Telephoned local police from here.
Lost sight of object while at this location.
